Steven M. Miller: BETWEEN NOISE AND SILENCE

Miller (1965–2014) was a composer, musician, and educator whose creative work drew on many sources, including Indonesian gamelan, improvisation, environmental sound, and live electronic processing. His music is characterized by its powerful sonic presence, often accompanied by a sensual, almost exotic, beauty.

This eight-disc set includes six CDs of works by Steven M. Miller, both solo and with others, a DVD of his collaborations with filmmaker Michael Saul, and a tribute CD of previously unreleased works by his friends and colleagues: Annea Lockwood, David Dunn, Steve Peters, Gregory Taylor, Dino J.A. Deane, Chris Brown, Pauline Oliveros, David Mahler, and Maggi Payne.
